second edition abigail greene by nature an english colonial by nurture a native pequot indian found as an infant in a burned out farm house and raised by a young pequot woman they were sold into puritan slavery for the rest of their lives armed with a streak of independence and drive abigail taught herself to read write and master the higher levels of arithmetic a skill that would serve her well in the colony s grooving trade business her mathematical genius captivated the attention of a wealthy landowner sir john smith of barbados beneath his fine english clothes manner and speech were scars of a dark hidden past together they shared a mysterious history of connections and passions that slowly unwind at times fusing them together and at others bringing into a fiery clash of ideals connecticut 1637 provides a forgotten view into colonial life from the small village of guilford to the grand international port of bridgetown barbados a city which held
